<p>Aeration</p>	<p>Aeration can improve the health and appearance of your lawn. Aeration involves punching holes into the soil to relieve compaction and allow water, air, and nutrients to reach the grassroots.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will schedule a one-time service from the third week of August until the third week of September. • For best results, irrigate the entire lawn the night before the service. • All irrigation heads must be flagged before service. If you do not have flags, you should be available to mark all heads before we begin.
<p>Aeration and Overseeding</p>	<p>Aeration and overseeding are lawn care practices that can improve the health and appearance of your lawn. Aeration involves punching holes into the soil to relieve compaction and allow water, air, and nutrients to reach the grassroots.</p> <p>Overseeding consists of spreading grass seed over the existing turf to fill in bare spots and encourage new growth. When done together, these processes can maximize their benefits.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will schedule a one-time service from the third week of August until the third week of September. • For best results, irrigate for 30 minutes the night before service. After the service, irrigate for 15 mins per zone three times per day, ideally at 4 AM, 12 PM, and 5 PM, for 1-2 weeks. • All irrigation heads must be flagged before service. If you do not have flags, let us know and we will drop flags off in the days beforehand. This may come at an extra charge. • Lawns that grow slowly should not be mowed for two weeks after application. Lawns that grow fast (4-5 inches of total growth) should continue to be mowed to prevent shading. • Once germination occurs (when green shoots spring up from the ground), you can scale back irrigation to one deep soak daily, ideally 30 minutes at 4 AM, for one week.

Dethatching	Removing layers of dead grass to promote aeration and absorption of fertilizer.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This is a per-request service. Fall Clean Up: 1 Visit	<p>Sticks and debris will be removed; leaves will be mulched into leaf mulch and blown onto beds. Leaves can be removed from the property for an additional charge.</p> <p>The one-visit option is our most cost-effective option. There may be leftover leaves and debris going into the winter season.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We typically wait until the end of the fall season to schedule a one-day cleanup (usually between November and December). Wet weather can adversely affect the quality of the leaf mulch. If you have a spring cleanup scheduled, we can regrind the mulch and distribute it more evenly in the spring to create a perfected look. Ensure that you have a notepad or a phone to take notes on.
Gardening - Basic Service	<p>4-hour visit which includes weeding as well as deadheading, pruning, and transplanting as needed.</p> <p>Additional fee of \$25 per cubic yard of brush disposal.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monthly service visits from May through October. Rose and other winter pruning services are separate services not included in Basic Gardening Services. Please contact the admin staff to make specific requests for your monthly gardening visit. We will do our best within the 4-hour timeframe to meet your requests. If more time is required, our office will contact you to schedule an extra visit. If your property's gardening goals require more than our Basic Gardening service, we can provide Premium Gardening Services.

<p>Irrigation - Repair</p>	<p>We will fix any problems with your irrigation system that we noticed during your Spring Irrigation Check.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before our visit, please ensure that our crew can access the irrigation and water panel. • Ensure that anything that can't get wet is not outside.
<p>Irrigation - Spring Check</p>	<p>We will check and adjust the orientation of sprinkler heads. Then, we will determine whether any sprinkler heads are broken and whether other repairs are necessary.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic sprinkler head adjustment is included. • Before our visit, please ensure that our crew can access the irrigation panel. • Ensure that anything that can't get wet is not outside. • An additional estimate will be sent for complex repairs.

<p>Mulch Application</p>	<p>The service includes mulch application to the desired coverage and depth—typically between 1 and 2 inches. It also includes edging and minimal weeding of all mulched beds.</p> <p>We use D&H Loam mulch and offer the following products: Hemlock Bark, Pine Bark, Natural Black, Enhanced Black, Mad Mics (horse bedding and leaves), Playground Mulch, and Woodchips.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will schedule one mulch application in the early spring. • We will contact you before your visit about your preferred mulch. There is no difference in cost. • Before our visit, please ensure the areas needing mulch are free of dog droppings and excessive weeds and debris. • We may reduce the new mulch depth if there is considerable build-up from prior seasons or plant ground cover. • All mulch is billed by the cubic yard. We will estimate the amount required for your property and contact you if more is needed. • Services available for an additional fee: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Extensive weeding of areas to be mulched. •
<p>Predatory Nematodes</p>	<p>Nematodes are naturally occurring, chemical-free organisms that attack various garden and lawn pests. We use a Tri-Nematode Attack method, which involves three species of nematodes.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will schedule a one-time service to be applied in May or when conditions allow. Ideal conditions are temperatures over 55 degrees and a reasonable amount of moisture in the soil. • For best results, ensure that the area is irrigated fully after application. • While nematodes are an excellent option for controlling lawn and garden pests, they can be affected by conditions such as frigid winters and drought. • Typically, nematodes stay in the soil and become more effective over time. Be patient; you'll enjoy a chemical—and pest-free lawn in a few years.
<p>Sand/Salt Driveway Application</p>	<p>Applying a salt and sand mix to the driveway.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applied after a snowstorm
<p>Sand/Salt Road Application</p>	<p>Applying a salt and sand mix to roads.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applied after a snowstorm
<p>Sand/Salt Sidewalk Application</p>	<p>Applying a salt and sand mix to sidewalks.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applied after a snowstorm



Snow Removal - Plowing Driveway	We will plow the driveway of your property.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Typically, we will plow when the area has at least one inch of wet snow and 2 inches of dry snow. • For large storms, there will be a visit every 4-5 inches, depending on the density of the snow. • If you determine you want us to wait to plow after the storm is over, please contact our admin office.
Snow Removal - Plowing Shared Road	We will plow a shared road.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Typically, we will plow when the area has at least one inch of wet snow and 2 inches of dry snow. • For large storms, there will be a visit every 4-5 inches, depending on the density of the snow. • If you determine you want to plow the following day, please contact our admin office.
Snow Removal - Shoveling Walkways	We will shovel the desired walkways on your property.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When we come to plow your property, we will clear snow from walkways. If it is a severe storm, this may be delayed until the last pass.
Snow Removal - Snow Blowing	We will use a snow blower to remove snow from the areas discussed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will use a snow blower to clear snow when we plow your property. • If it is a severe storm, this may be delayed to the last pass.
Spring Clean Up	<p>Winter debris clean-up for your property includes salt, sand, sticks, leaves, and other vegetation.</p> <p>Leaves will be mulched or stored on the property. They can also be removed for an extra fee.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will schedule one visit between March and April • Before our visit, please clean up and remove excess dog droppings and any items preventing access to winter debris. • Services available for an extra fee: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Debris removal. ○ Large branch removal. ○ Clean-up of excessive plow damage.
Stake Placement	Placing snow stakes along your driveway or walking areas to guide the snow removal process.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All stakes should be placed one foot from the driveway • Please ensure you have enough stakes to be placed; if you need them, we have them available for purchase.
Stakes	Wooden stakes driven into the ground to outline your driveway and protect your lawn from plow damage.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$0.70 per stake.



<p>Tree Removal</p>	<p>We will remove your tree to the stump level of one foot tall and discard all debris related to the removed tree.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all patio furniture, fencing, and vehicles are removed from the tree's drop zone. If you are unaware of what this is, please let us know. • Ensure that children and pets are not on the property when we take the tree down. • Ensure that woodchippers, trailers, and other machines can reach the tree. • We will discuss the best route and time of year to remove your tree. Note that some damage to lawns and surrounding areas can occur. EcoQuiet is not responsible for everyday wear and tear to the area.
